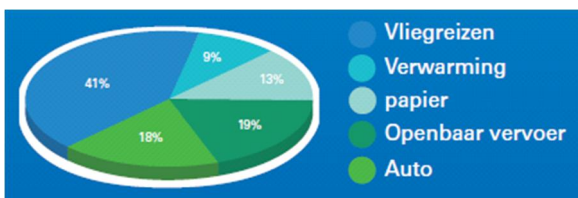
Phase insight: CO₂ footprint

Calculating your CO₂ footprint

To gain an understanding of your company's present CO₂ emissions, we will perform the calculations and present them to your organisation in a conveniently arranged CO₂ footprint. By identifying your CO₂ emissions, whether it is total emissions for your organisation, or emissions from an event or a production line, the most important sources of CO₂ emissions quickly become obvious. We will refer to the CO₂ footprint for an entire organisation in the text below, but the methods and results are the same for a production line or an event.

How do we set to work?

The calculations are made on the basis of an inventory form. The form is filled out, with our help if necessary, and the calculations are made. When calculating the CO₂ emissions we use the most recent nationally and internationally recognised figures that are available. Ask us for a brochure providing more information on the methods and values we use. You will receive the final calculations in the form of a clear summary: your CO₂ footprint.



What can you do with the outcome?

The CO₂ footprint will immediately show the biggest causes of CO₂ emissions in your company. Are they caused by transportation, or is it the production process? Or both? This information guides the reduction process by pointing out what reduction measures are applicable to the relevant causes of CO₂.



The CO₂ footprint not only offers an insight into potential emission reduction measures, it also serves as a baseline measure: once the emission cuts have been implemented a new CO₂ footprint will show what emission reduction has been achieved.
